Kei Heep Skype English Salon Program

Would you like to spend 30 minutes a week to help students of Kei Heep Secondary School in Hong Kong to improve their English level by chatting with them on skype in an English Salon Program.

For this term, 26 students (F.2 to F.5) have signed up to participate in the program. The program will be conducted in two phases. The first phase will be held in groups so that the students may be better prepared for the two to one sessions in phase two.

- 1. For the first phase, a total of 3 "Saturday" sessions of 30 minutes each between 10:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. will be held during the month of March. (March 5, 12 and 19) For this phase, we will need 5 volunteers to engage in discussion with the students in groups.
- 2. The second phase consisting of 8 sessions of 30 minutes each will begin on April 9 through June 4 (April 9, 16, 23 and 30; May 7, 21 and 28; June 4). Subject to the availability of volunteers, the students will engage in the discussion with the volunteers in pairs (1 volunteer with 2 students). For this phase, we will need 13 volunteers for each session.

In addition to the volunteers who will talk to the students via skype, we will also need volunteers to monitor each session to ensure that the discussion is in line with the intent of the program as well as providing assistance to the students if necessary.

One other very important function of the "monitors" is to monitor the students' performance and award the students with additional signatures for both good preparation shown, active participation and being punctual. These signatures collected by the students will be redeemed by the students for raffle tickets at the end of the term. Each signature would be redeemable for one raffle ticket and one chance to win the raffle draw prizes.

Only students who have attended <u>at least</u> 9 out of the 11 sessions will be eligible to redeem the signatures for raffle draw as well as participating in a day trip and campus tour of the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology with lunch and transport provided.

A schedule and the topic of discussion for each session is attached below. Participating students are required to show commitment to improve their English and to prepare for each discussion beforehand. The first half hour (9:30 a.m. to 10 a.m. will be spent in taking attendance and final preparation for the discussion.
